A day of spirit-filled joy

Pentecost Sunday 5 June 2022

Ac 2:1-11 Rom 8:8-17 Jn 14: 15-16, 23-26

Of all the days in the Christian calendar, Pentecost Sunday is among the most joyous and hope-filled. But unlike Christmas and Easter Sunday, it is seldom associated with celebration and does not have a national holiday like Christmas and Easter Monday. Yet, if we truly understand what Pentecost means to our faith, we should shout out our joy and fill the church today with spirit-filled happiness. Today's readings explain why Pentecost is such a wondrous occasion.

What are we celebrating?

First, it marks the birthday of the Church, the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles to begin their mission of continuing our Lord's work to free the world from sin. On Pentecost, we celebrate the fulfilment of the blessing the Church first received from the risen Christ when he breathed the Holy Spirit into our first leaders, and proclaimed:

"Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you...Receive the Holy Spirit." (Jn 21:21)

The task before them was daunting but they could not have had a more powerful send off for their Master had breathed new life into them and poured the Holy Spirit into their hearts. We are blessed with the same spirit, and that is truly worth celebrating.

Second, we celebrate the life-giving nature of the Holy Spirit. It is not easy

to understand the divine mystery of the Holy Spirit who is consubstantial with the Father and the Son. The second reading offers a profound insight: The Spirit lives in us!

"People who are interested only in unspiritual things can never be pleasing to God. Your interests, however, are not in the unspiritual, since the Spirit of God has made a home in you. In fact, unless you possessed the Spirit of Christ you would not belong to him." (Rom 8:8-9)

Therefore, we can only truly celebrate the Church's birthday today if the Holy Spirit is in us, and the celebration that we mark is really one of belonging to Christ.

The Catechism captures the relationship between the Holy Spirit, the Church and our Lord succinctly:

"The mission of the Holy Spirit in the liturgy of the Church is to prepare the assembly to encounter Christ; to recall and manifest Christ to the faith of the assembly; to make the saving work of Christ present and active by his transforming power; and to make the gift of communion bear fruit in the Church." (CCC 1112)

Finally, we celebrate the transformative power of the Spirit. Throughout scripture, whenever the Spirit is invoked, there is change, upheaval, and renewal. It begins in Genesis and is manifested throughout the Old and New Testament:

- "then the Lord God formed man from the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living thing." (Gen 2: 7)
- I will pour my spirit upon your descendants...They shall spring up like a green tamarisk, like willows by flowing streams." (Is 44: 3-4)

 "When Pentecost day came around, the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven... and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire." (Ac 2: 1-3)

Our experience with the Spirit might not seem as dramatic, but the change it brings is no less radical. How can it not be when it is the difference between life and death, as the second reading makes clear,

"...though your body may be dead it is because of sin, but if Christ is in you then your spirit is life itself..." (Rom 8: 10)

The Holy Spirit is not an external agent sent by God to help us. It dwells in us and cannot be separated from who we are and our relationship with the Lord. We live because of the Spirit in us. It is this spirit-filled life that we celebrate today.

When you sing the responsorial psalm, "Send forth your Spirit, O Lord, and renew the face of the earth" (Ps 103), make sure to fill the sanctuary with the spirit of your unbridled happiness to celebrate the fulfilment of all that had been promised.
