Called to be Fire

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time 14 Aug 2022

Jer 38:4-6, 8-10 Hebr 12:1-4 Lk 12:49-53

In a world struggling with war, disease and a myriad of injustices, the Church's proclamation that God loves the world may be hard for many to believe. If there is truly a loving God, why is there so much human suffering? Jesus' call to us in today's gospel to be his fire in the world is timely for we live in a world seeking healing and truth.

Today's readings speak of this call. In the first reading, the prophet Jeremiah is persecuted for opposing the political intrigues of the king's advisors. He was thrown into a cistern by the court officials to die but was saved by the Ethiopian Ebed-melech who risked being politically incorrect to rescue him. Jeremiah had spent most of his life speaking the difficult messages from God, thereby risking his own life. He wants to keep quiet, but there is an inner conflict within him. He would say to himself, "I will not think about him, I will not speak in his name anymore, but then there seemed to be a fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones. The effort to restrain it wearied me, I could not do it." (Jer 20:9)

It is this fire that Jesus speaks of in the gospel when he says, "I have come to bring fire to the earth and how I wish it were blazing already." (Lk 12:49) God's fire compels Jeremiah and all of us who are baptised to speak the truth. We



are entrusted with this fire of faith to keep it burning till Jesus comes again.

Just like the Holy Spirit came like tongues of fire to ignite the members of the early church with the passion to preach the good news, Jesus came to set us on fire with the living flame of love for God. It is important for each of us to allow the Holy Spirit to burn in us and melt the cold indifference in our hearts, as the greatest obstacle to our proclaiming our faith and bringing people to God is being lukewarm towards Jesus.

A reason that we are lukewarm and resist being on fire is that we are afraid of losing things dear to us. Jesus, in today's gospel, reminds his disciples to be prepared for difficulties that will bring them into conflict with those closest to them, including their families.

While the commandments say that we are to honour our parents, we can only obey them if their wishes are not against God's will. Disobeying our parents in such situations will fracture the peace we have with them. That is why Jesus says that he has not come to bring peace but division. The decision to do the right thing or the good thing is not always easy and demands huge sacrifices. The book of Hebrews says we must

"throw off everything that hinders us..." and this may even include family members who want to prevent us from serving God.

We, who have been confirmed, have a share in Jesus' prophetic anointing. Like Jeremiah, we will face opposition and may even have to risk our lives in some situations, but like him we must be strong and fearless. We too have the gift of fortitude through the Holy Spirit. Our God will always come to the aid of his children in times of trouble as the Psalmist reveals: "I waited and waited for the Lord, and he stooped down to save me, he heard my cry." (Ps 40:1) With this assurance of God's help, let us "keep running steadily in the race we have started, let us not lose sight of Jesus, who leads us in our faith and brings it to perfection." (Hebr 12:1-2)

The truth that God commands us to share is sometimes in contrast to the culture of the world but we should not allow our fear of others' opinions to get in the way of our mission. Our mission is to be on fire with love, on fire with passion to set the world ablaze and fill it with God's light. In the words of St Catherine of Siena, "Be who God made you to be, and you will set the world on fire." This is our call.






THE BIBLE AND THE VIRGIN MARY: EPISODE 11: THE ASSUMPTION

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The sacrament can be administered to any Catholic awaiting serious surgery, suffering from serious illness or weakened by old age. Anointing may be given before admission for the anticipated medical procedure. Contact the Parish Office to request for a priest. In emergencies, priests of the church nearest to the hospital can be contacted.

INFANT BAPTISM

Spiritual preparation is held on the last Friday of every odd month. Baptism is held on the first Sunday of the following month. For registration, please refer to our website.

FUNERAL

Please check with the Parish Office for priest availability and Mass timing before confirming the timing at the crematorium. For prayers at the wake, please contact the Parish Office.

MARRIAGE

Contact the Parish Office 12 months before your intended date to book the church premises and ensure that your presiding priest is able to make that date.

MASS OFFERING

Mass offering envelopes are available outside the Parish Office. Submit your envelopes at least two weeks in advance of your intended date. Please write the names clearly, and in block letters.
