Our King Lives!

Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ,
King of the Universe
20 Nov 2022

2 Sam: 5:1-3
Col 1: 12-20
Lk 23: 35-43

Today is the last Sunday of the liturgical year which ends fittingly in the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Pope Pius XI first established this Feast as Christ the King in 1925 and Pope St Paul VI expanded its name to King of the Universe in 1969.

Our Holy Father instituted it in response to the growing secularism and nationalism especially in Europe that threatened world peace and religious practice.

This concern is as relevant today. What does it mean to acknowledge our Lord's kingship?

The second reading makes clear his complete sovereignty over everything.

"He is the image of the unseen God, and the first-born of all creation. for in him were created all things in heaven and on earth, everything visible and everything invisible... all things were created through him and for him." (Col 1: 15-16)

It can be hard to wrap our heads around this all-encompassing God who is everywhere but sometimes also nowhere when we become distracted in our daily struggle amidst the trappings of the modern world. But, in fact, it is precisely because there is so much going on all around us that we need a strong centre to hold on to.

When Jesus is at the centre of our

lives, God is naturally everywhere.

Pope Pius XI in his 1925 encyclical puts it this way:

"He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things, and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls..." (Quas Primas, 33)

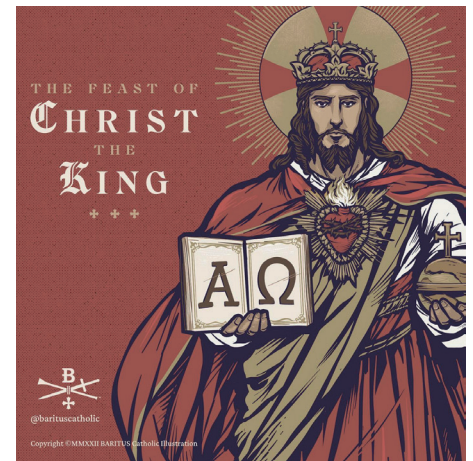
We could say Pope Pius XI is challenging our self-identity and asking us how we see ourselves in the universe that God has created. It is often said that we have many identities - as father, mother, son, daughter, citizen, employer, worker, and so on. They are all valid, and make us who we are. But they can also pull us in different directions and make us lose our way in the world.

With Christ at the centre of our lives we are no longer confused by our multiple identities. When we accept Christ's sovereignty, we identify completely with him first and foremost. In other words, only in Christ is our true identity revealed. Only in Christ do we really know who we are and what we are to do. And only in Christ is there hope that we will achieve our mission and attain eternal salvation.

Next, comes the question of what sort of sovereign is he? The Gospel reading answers this perfectly. When Jesus was being crucified, the thief on the cross next to him repented of his sins, asking,

"Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." (Lk 23:42)

Jesus replied: "Amen, I say to you. Today you will be with me in Paradise." (Lk 23:43)

Our Lord revealed his kingship on the cross, and it is one of love and mercy. No one is beyond his compassion and it is never too late to repent of one's sins.

Pope Francis in his homily in 2013 had a wonderful way of expressing this. "Jesus' promise to the good thief gives us great hope: it tells us that God's grace is always greater than the prayer which sought it. The Lord always grants more, he is so generous, he always gives more than what he has been asked: you ask him to remember you, and he brings you into his kingdom!" (Homily, 24 Nov 2013)

With such a king, how can we not "spurn [our] natural desires" (Quas Primas, 33) and respond with his gift of the supernatural desire of faith to identify completely with him?

As the liturgical year comes to an end and we prepare for Advent, let us put Christ at the centre of our lives.

Our King Lives!

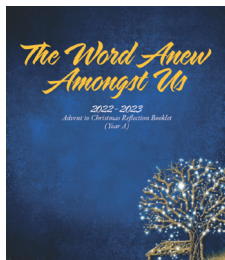
EVANGELISTIC PILGRIMAGE WALK
