The Yoke and the Cross

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time 5 Jul 2020

Zec 9:9-10 Rom 8:9, 11-13 Mt 11:25-30

"Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest. Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. Yes, for my yoke is easy and my burden light."

This is a familiar passage to Christians. We quote it when we are stressed, bogged down by todo lists, burdened by duties and responsibilities. When the world seems too heavy to carry, this passage brings us comfort.

But exchanging our heavy worldly burdens for Jesus' lighter yoke is not easy, ironic as that may seem. As CS Lewis writes in *Mere Christianity*, "It means unlearning all the selfconceit and self-will that we have been training ourselves into for thousands of years. It means killing part of yourself, undergoing a kind of death."

After years of striving for wealth, fame, popularity, and progress, that heavy worldliness is not just something that we *carry*, but something that we *are*. To give up that part of us is to die to ourselves.

As Lewis puts it, "Christ himself sometimes describes the Christian way as very hard, sometimes as very easy. He says, 'Take up your Cross'—in other words, it is like going to be beaten to death in a concentration camp. Next minute

he says, 'My yoke is easy and my burden light.' He means both." For to be yoked to him is to be yoked also to his life, death, and eventually, his resurrection.

In this regard, the second reading exhorts us: "Your interests are not in the unspiritual, but in the spiritual, since the Spirit of God has made his home in you... there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live."

This may sound daunting. But this gospel text is comforting because it reminds us that we do not do this on our own. Jesus invites us to go to him, not just to celebrate with him when we are joyful, but specifically when we are struggling. In fact, he is right there with us when we take up his yoke. Typically used between a pair of oxen, a yoke allows the strength of two animals to be combined to pull a load heavier than what one could have accomplished on its own. When we take up the yoke of Christ, we are thus assured that Christ is right there beside us, lifting and pulling along with us, as he did in the road to Calvary. This is the true meaning of *comfort* — with strength.

Pope Francis thus reassures us in *Gaudete Et Exsultate* at [24]: "Let yourself be transformed... The Lord will bring it to fulfilment despite your mistakes and missteps, provided that you do not abandon the path of love but remain ever open to his supernatural grace, which purifies and enlightens". In other words, provided that we remain yoked to him.

GRADUAL RESUMPTION OF MASSES IN JULY

Starting July, Masses will gradually resume. The booking of Masses at the Church of St Francis Xavier will commence at 12pm on Tues 14 July 2020.

- All parishioners will have to register themselves with the Archdiocese Mass Attendance Registration System (MARS).
- Registration Details:
 - 1. Register yourselves as Catholics residing in Singapore at **myCatholic.sg** from **Saturday 27 June 2020 9am** onwards.
 - 2. Choose only **ONE** church (can't be changed) that you will be attending during this time (Covid-19 Phase 2 onwards). Church 'hopping' is strictly not allowed.
- Each Mass is limited to a maximum of 50 registered persons. Strictly no walk-ins allowed.
- Mass bookings must be made **individually**. Family bookings are currently not available.

Kindly note that these measures are in place so as to ensure the safety of everyone and an equal opportunity for everyone to attend Mass.

For those who do not have access to a mobile phone, computer or internet, kindly get in touch with the Parish Office and we will assist you. Alternatively, you can ask your family or friends for help.

The adoration room, columbarium and the sacrament of reconciliation remain unavailable for now.

Online Masses by the Archbishop will continue to be made available.

Young children, the elderly (> 60 yr), and those with pre-existing medical conditions are considered vulnerable to the disease, and are highly encouraged to continue attending Mass online instead.
