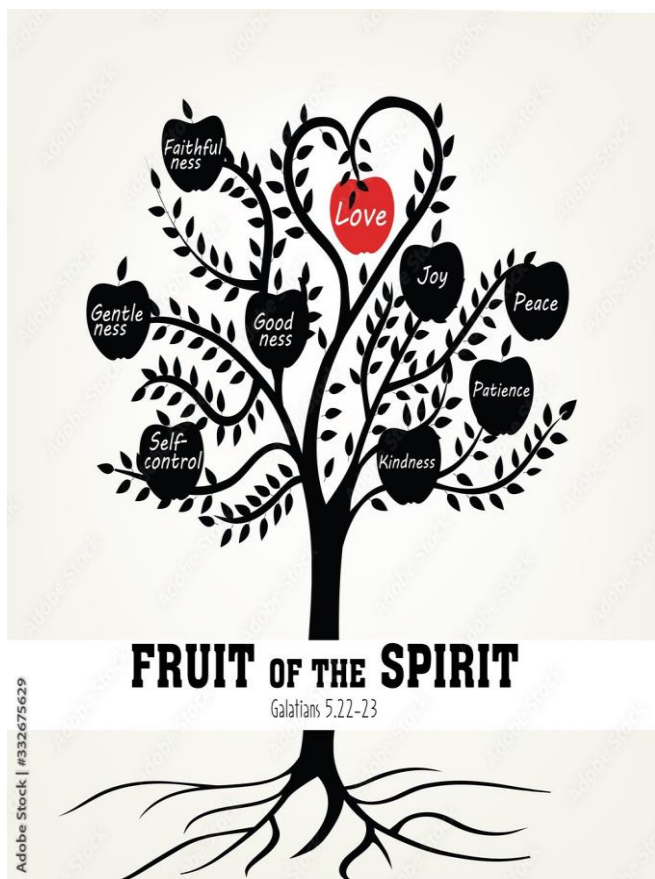

THE LIFE IN THE SPIRIT OVERVIEW

The Life in the Spirit programme is designed to heighten awareness of the Spirit of God working in our personal lives and in the life of the Church, to remove any barrier we might have to the Holy Spirit moving in our lives and to create a greater openness to the fullness of the Holy Spirit.

During the Life in the Spirit, the grace of God, the love of Jesus Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit become active in the worship, the short teachings and the personal testimonies of faith that are shared by group members.

Participants will discover the potential and the power of the Holy Spirit to lead, guide and direct their lives into the fullness of Christ Jesus that God offers to every believer.

Participants will also be encouraged and challenged to receive “the Promise of the Father” and to begin walking with Jesus in the power of the Holy Spirit.

WHAT YOU WILL RECEIVE AND EXPERIENCE

Life in the Spirit will prepare participants to turn to the Lord in a deeper way and to establish a more effective, personal relationship with the Lord. Those who have experienced the outpouring of the Holy Spirit have:

- Developed a new love of God and a zeal to serve Him and His People
- Developed a desire to pray, spend time with God in personal prayer and to attend daily mass
- Developed a greater commitment to read scripture, other spiritual readings and to learn more about the ways of God

Good evening Father, dear brothers and sisters in Christ. Erwin Zee is my name. First, I would like to apologise for delaying your dinner by about 5 minutes. I understand how some of your feelings as I also used to be irritated by speakers sharing after Holy Communion. I already dragged myself to mass and still have to be delayed by people like me now. You see, I used to be a Sunday Catholic after National Service. And then I became a Feast Day Catholic, and finally a Catholic just in forms-filling. For me, Sunday mass obligation just became that, an obligation, a chore. Something that I didn't want to do but had to and so how to tahan people like me? Delaying me going on to do somethings more important. I was so caught up with work and always giving myself excuses not to come to mass. From busy working to being tired and even having fun is more important. I was pursuing all the worldly things, thinking that these will make me happy, and thereby, peace. I was living a life that was so wrong. Almost anything and everything I did was so very wrong in the way GOD wants me to live. I thank GOD that He brought me back to church when I had a great fall, but even then, I came back with a wrong mindset and wrong attitude. It was during this time that I felt a stirring to attend the Parish retreat, Road To Emmaus. That's another story. Like that I don't want to attend already”. Then almost immediately Roderick say, “It's ok, I'll submit for you”. So I guess I can't siam already.

GOD works in mysterious ways and it was an amazing journey during and after LISS, serving in the Charismatic Prayer Group. Now I look forward to weekend mass, our weekly Charismatic Prayer Group meetings and nightly meetup on zoom to pray with my brother and sisters. Trying my best to serve with GOD's blessings, wanting to get closer to GOD and have a greater personal relationship with HIM. I'm so grateful to GOD for HIS immense love and HIS Graces and Blessings upon me. Dear brothers and sisters-in-Christ, I'm Rose. Owing to my current working hours, most of the time, I'm not able to join any church group. That day, while somebody went up to the pulpit to talk about LISS, I thought to myself: if I am given the pamphlet, maybe I would consider it. Do you believe that God would always call us at a time we least expected it? True enough, I was given the pamphlet on LISS. I tried to convince myself I should give it a miss, citing reasons like it would end late, I had to miss my favourite TV programme and so forth. As days passed, these negative excuses disturbed me very much especially on looking at the picture of the dove, that is, the Holy Spirit. It is a calling I cannot ignore. In the end, I said to myself, "If I want to go, just go. Don't think of it anymore. It is just only 2 months."

At first, I was curious and excited what would happen as I have zero knowledge on it. If I did not remember wrongly, on the 2nd session of our group sharing, I shared the incident leading to my grandma's death. As I related it, tears swelled up in my eyes and I started to cry. So many eyes looked at me, I just could not care about it. It was surprising that when I reflected, I had not let go of her death until that moment. After that crying, I felt relieved and that Jesus had healed the deepest wound of my life. For the next few sessions, we participants were enlightened about the roles of the Holy Spirit in us, something not learnt in baptism or confirmation. I also find joy in singing for the Lord in our praise and worship. In our group sharing, we learned from each other how God has touched us amidst our sufferings. One thing to note is that all these sharing were kept confidential within the group and not to be shared outside.

After LISS, I have grown spiritually in my faith. I try to see in my everyday life an occasion to love God and our brothers and sisters. In our everyday sufferings, I would always associate it with Jesus' sufferings in carrying the cross for us – the patience, tiredness and perseverance despite the scourging, falling and bleeding of wounds. The crucifix is a reminder and an example of how our Lord had thrown away His pride in dying like that for us – naked, mocked, humiliated and embarrassed. I find myself thanking the Lord every day for His blessings upon me for having a job to earn my living; for having family members and relatives to love and care for and a general healthy life to take care of myself independently. In conclusion, I called you all, whether young or old, to accept this invitation Christ our Lord has offered to you. Come, if you want to experience the Holy Spirit working in you. Come, if you want to accept the peace that Jesus has left for you. It will not be a thing to regret for.

My experience during LISS

At the beginning, I didn't know what to expect but I was pleasantly surprised with the service team as they were so filled with positive energy and bright loving smiles. Throughout the journey, I was really cared by the facils and faith was gradually strengthened as the journey progressed.

- A deep sense of peace, calmness and quietness. A moment of closeness made me cry and soon felt relieved and calm again. As I went into the presence of the God saw flashes of twinkling light and sparkles around.
- One moment I saw a deep well of fire flaming brightly which flashed for a second and disappear. Felt the sins of the world and a need to pray for all souls in pain and agony. All the while mostly I experience a quietness and peace and need to be just stay in the presence of peace. Did not feel worried and need of want but just to be there waiting to be there for God and do his will. Nothing spectacular only PEACE and CALMNESS.
- When the Holy Spirit came down upon me, I offer in prayers. So, I feel very relieved and tears start rolling non-stop. I cried for quite a while over 5 mins. Then I speak strange language. That must be tongue speaking. Then stop and start singing again. Praise the Lord
- I learned much of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit that I am loved and have received much from the Lord Jesus, although I have not received the Gift of Tongue. I lie in wait and just know that God is in charge and His will be done. I will continue to love and serve Him in every facet of my life. Thank you, Lord Jesus, I love you with all my heart
- It was a beautiful feeling of being relieved of burden and a lightened load lovely fellowship and experience of the Charismatic ministering praying over each of us. Although I did not receive the Gift of tongue, it was still a beautiful experience. Thank you all for making tis so special
- This is the first time I joined LISS and it has been a great experience as a newly baptised. During the praying over, I felt a sense of relief, I felt that the Holy Spirit is surrounding me, holding me, and my fear just flow. Praise the Lord. Thank you, Holy Spirit, for guiding me. Amen
- The sessions were very enriching and fulfilling. I feel at Peace with myself. During the session I feel my thought all are away from me. I can feel being calm and the Holy Spirit is resting on me. My sorrow and worry are taking away from.
- Throughout the LISS seminars I have been constantly touched by God through Praise and Worship. Tears could flow effortlessly, and my heart felt so light. Sense the topic each week seemed to speak to me directly as if God is answering me. I am thankful for the gift of community and sharing as it strengthened my faith even further. During the pray over session, I could feel strange wind (not air-con) passing through me. It feels like God's presence and again I couldn't control my tears. I feel like my burden is light. I am certain that I have been healed. Praise the Lord.

- I was very apprehensive coming for this session and frightened only on the very evening. Enlightening journey, understanding the power of the Holy Spirit and how His gift can support the community. When I was prayed over, I felt waves of cold and warm lights. Body felt light and injured leg started to get tingling sensation and painful. Tears started to fall, and I felt the Holy Spirit showing me His presence. Knowledge gained over the sessions enable me to remove my fear of Charismatic practises of speaking in tongue. Pray that I will continue to grow in my spiritual with God.
- Wow! It was an experience that I did not expect. I was initially apprehensive, today but previous week was more tearful and has been wondering if I'm holy enough and even ready. But I guess, during these past few weeks, I have been doing my "homework" to pray more and always calling on the Lord. So, when even before I was told to close my eyes, my tears have been rolling down. And when I was told to my eyes, first my head got light-headed, my tongue started "le, le, le....." and my body kept rocking back and forth. Each time the rocking gets stronger when being prayed over. I then knew I have had the answer I always doubted and asked, "where is the Holy Spirit?" Today, I witnessed, it is here and in me! Praise the Lord.
- Four years ago, I participated in LISS and was blessed with the Gift of tongue. Praying in tongue transformed my prayer life and it give me tremendous strength during the most difficult time in 2014 when one daughter was born asleep. This time with confidence I invited my wife to journey together in this LISS knowing that her spiritual life can be transformed too. Tonight, at the baptism of the Holy Spirit, I first felt a sense of warmth, with God reassuring for all the things I have been doing, especially on the faith formation of our children and of the children in the catechism session. Then, I rested in the Spirit. I continue to desire for the Gift of knowledge to help me to journey with people, children and adults, to bring them to Christ

From the moment when the leader prayed over me, I had this feeling of the Lord coming close to me telling me to pray and receive the Holy Spirit. I cried and cried, and I cried.
